

The 20/9 Radio Club, Inc.
Constitution

Preamble

We, the members, wishing to secure for ourselves the benefits of the association, commonly interested in amateur radio and electronics, do hereby constitute ourselves the **20/9 RADIO CLUB, INC.** and do enact this Constitution as our governing laws.

It shall be our purpose:

1. To educate, facilitate and promote the use of radio and other communication in the event of emergencies and other natural disasters;
2. To provide timely and accurate weather reports for the National Weather Service and Safety Services
3. To provide communications for, Not For Profit, community and government organizations;
4. To promote the exchange of information, individual operating efficiency, fraternalism and general cooperation between members; and
5. To conduct activities and programs, to educate the general public, and to continue the general interest and welfare of the members.

ARTICLE 1 - OFFICERS

SECTION 1. The Officers of the club will be:

- A. President
- B. Vice President
- C. Secretary
- D. Treasurer

SECTION 2 - TRUSTEES

In addition to the above Officers there shall be Three (3) Trustees.

SECTION 3 - In the absence of the President the order of descending authority is as follows:

- A. Vice President
- B. Secretary
- C. Treasurer
- D. Trustee

ARTICLE 2 - MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1. There shall be four (4) classes of membership.

- A. Full Membership
- B. Family Membership
- C. Social Membership
- D. Lifetime Membership

ARTICLE 3 - MEETINGS:

The Bylaws shall provide for regular and special meetings.

ARTICLE 4 - Dissolution of the Club

Should there come a time because of changes in the Ohio law or for other reasons that a voluntary or involuntary dissolution of the 20/9 Radio Club Inc. occur, the provisions of Section 1702.47 through 1702.521 inclusive of the Ohio Revised Code shall be complied with. Upon payment of all just debts and obligations all remaining assets shall be applied so far as it is feasible toward carrying out the purpose spelled out in the Article Preamble of this Constitution and in no event shall the remaining assets be distributed among the remaining club members per capita or in any other fashion.

ARTICLE 5 - RULES

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the organization in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with the Bylaws of this organization.

ARTICLE 6 - AMENDMENTS

The Articles of this Constitution shall be amended by a quorum of members as defined in the Bylaws.
