PROCEDURES TO APPLY FOR A 3B8 VISITORS LICENCE

1. To obtain a licence you must send :

- (a) the application form
- (b) One copy of the first page of Passport.
- (c) One copy of your Amateur Licence(home)
- (d) One passportsize photo.

- 3. Send at least 90 days in advance - 120 days is better.**
- 4. Fee payable when licence is delivered about 40 U. S dollars. Do not send money with the application.**
- 5. Call sign usually 3B8/ home callsign.**
- 6. It is a good practice to send a copy to the Mauritius Amateur Radio Society (M.A.R.S) so that we can answer any question if needed.**
- 7. Please give the name and address of a contact person in Mauritius. If you do not know any body, please contact the secretary of MARS, who will advise you what to do.**
