Winlink 2000 / AirMail

There are 2 things one needs to do to get started in AirMail or WL2K.

First; join the MARS_WL2K yahoo reflector group at:

http://groups.yahoo.com/group/mars_wl2k/

There you will have to log in and register, the Group Moderator will grant you access as soon as he verifies your MARS Call sign.

On this reflector there are all the latest information and support documents. On this group you can post questions and receive answers from the 1000 or so group members that have probably gone through just what you are going through. There you can benefit from the knowledge, and experience of the group members.

The second place you need to go is:

www.winlink.org

Again you will have to log in and register. The moderator will send you a password via email, to complete your registration. This site has additional resources and information such as the interactive "WinLink for Dummies" online course and many others.

These 2 sites are great resource of knowledge and experience, they will get you up and running with AirMail and keep you up to date with the latest information.
