"I thank my God in all my remeberance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel..." - Philippians 1:3-5 (ESV) A Partnership with Tribal Horse Evangelism On June 14-18, we took three tribal pastors and an intern to attend a 5-day seminar in basic horsemanship in Valencia, Bukidnon where they learned about hoof-care, grooming, feeding practices, basic medical conditions, organic remedies, riding skills, etc. The training was conducted by a Canadian missionary couple, *Darrel & Shannon Nelson* who serve with *Tribal Horse Evangelism*. This is a very unique and needed ministry since tribal pastor/farmers rely on horses for their farm work and transportation. We met Darrel & Shannon at a gathering in the home of an American missionary couple

in Davao City last year which resulted in friendship and partnership in ministry. We are amazed to see how God puts

Quail Project – Livelihood Partnership

Leo Pareño is an agriculturalist who has specialized in poultry production. He is also the newest member of the Hope Mountain Board of Trustees. Leo recently retired



from an agricultural company and has now ventured into a second career with the raising of *pugo* (quail). Quail eggs are very popular and are in great demand. What is exciting is that a small *pugo* operation can be set up at minimal cost and income can be generated very quickly. In May, Leo helped us set up a small *pug*o operation at Hope Mountain. We currently have 300 *pugo* and are already harvesting about 1,500 eggs per week. Within the next month

we'll have cages built for another 300 *pugo chicks*. The income offsets some of our agricultural operating expenses, and this small *pugo* operation provides **a model for livelihood training** that is greatly needed in a developing country like the Philippines. **The Hope MountainPugo project represents another partnership ministry that impacts thelives of needy people.** We praise the Lord for innovative, talented people like Leo Pareño who serves the Lord in very unique ways!
