Bayanihan

The Old Testament book of Nehemiah provides us with a powerful example of God's people working together. Nehemiah understood the necessity of teamwork. Having a passion to rebuild the wall around Jerusalem which was in shambles, diligently praying and then using his leadership skills, he put together a team of God's people to accomplish a task that, from a human perspective, was impossible. But in 52 days the wall was rebuilt, even with opposition and many difficulties. One of the most impressive chapters of the book of Nehemiah is chapter 3 which lists the builders of the wall. In this chapter the phrases "next to him," "next to them," "after him," and "after them." is used 31 times. Each group took responsibility for one part of the wall, and the job was completed in 52 days! **TEAMWORK IN ACTION!**

You may have wondered about the picture in the top left of our recent prayer updates. It's a group of Filipino people



carrying a **bahay**, a Filipino house. This picture reflects a Filipino value called **bayanihan**. Bayanihan is a community agreement to work together to accomplish short-term projects. Similar to the Amish barn -raising in North Amer-

ica, Filipino farmers will agree to help each other in the back-breaking job of planting rice fields and other difficult tasks. A challenging task is accomplished quicker and easier when people work shoulder to shoulder with each other. It's all about **TEAMWORK! TEAMWORK IN ACTION!**

We praise the Lord for the *teamwork* we see among God's people. We thank each of you who pray and generously give as part of the Mindanao WorldVenture team. And we praise the Lord for the people God brings into our lives, the people we form partnerships with to do what God has called us to do. The Lord gives each of His children unique gifts that contribute to the expansion of His kingdom and bring Him much glory.

Here on the mission field *teamwork is indispensible* and we constantly see *teamwork in action* as we work with other missionaries, mission organizations, and short-term mission teams. Here's a recent example of *teamwork in action*:

Raymund Geneston is a civil engineer and a committed Christian from Manila. He wanted to be involved in missions but just didn't know how he, as an engineer, could serve. **Dess Ventura**, his sister-law, who works as the

assistant manager of Hope Mountain shared with him the need for someone oversee the to renovation of one of Hope Mountain buildings. Last October he came to Davao City to look over the project, provided design recommendations

and provided a detailed list of materials and cost estimates for the project. In January he spent two weeks overseeing this needy project. Along with Raymund, **Glenn Biggs**, an Australian missionary with Global Impact who mentors and trains young Filipino men in the building trades, provided his expertise and some skilled workers to assist in the renovation. Some of our Hope Mountain staff also helped and with the great oversight and skill of Raymund and Glenn, **the team accomplished their particular part of the project.** This was **Teamwork in Action!** There's just a few minor finishing touches that are still in progress, and then the hanging of curtains, etc.
