The long awaited arrival of Mike & Ghed to the field is now a reality after much prayer and many months of preparation. Now begins the process of passing the baton of leadership to Mike as the new manager of Hope Mountain, and to Ghed as she partners with Mike and ministers through her special gifts. Both Mike and Ghed come with impeccable credentials. Mike is a CPA with many years of experience in both the Philippines and the United States. He is not only a great administrator; he is also an ordained pastor with a deep passion for the lost. Ghed is a registered nurse whose desire is to bring God's healing touch to people with few resources and little understanding of basic hygiene and health care. While both working full-time in the U.S. Mike and Ghed planted three churches together.

Please pray for Mike & Ghed. Although they are Filipinos, they have lived in the U.S. for over 20 years. They grew up in Luzon, which has a different culture than what they will experience here in Mindanao. They will have to learn a new language, Cebuano. Mike and Ghed not only have to adapt to a new culture, they have to set up a new home here, and they will be taking over the challenges of moving Hope Mountain forward in its development as a center for transformation. Mike will also be laying the ground work to establish Davao City as an "Epicenter" for Business as Mission. Business as Mission has the potential to greatly impact this culture with the Good News of Jesus Christ and His transforming grace and power. Everyone goes through transitions in life, and we're now in a big transition as we prepare for a new chapter in our lives.

Gloria has now served as a missionary in the Philippines for 23 years and Timothy for 8 years. This summer we will be returning to the States for **our final home assignment**, during which we will visit our supporting churches and individuals to share and to celebrate what God has done through our partnership together in the Philippines. Our home assignment will conclude at the end of February 2013,

at which time we will retire from full-time missionary service with WorldVenture and transition into part-time service in the U.S. with WorldVenture's North Central Regional Team.

As U.S. staff on special assignment we will assist with recruitment efforts as mission coaches to potential candidates, serve in the area of member care by helping missionary appointees prepare for living overseas, and foster church connections by doing mission training in local churches. The finer details of our role and our ongoing ministry support needs are still being worked out, but we're excited about the possibilities. We're also looking forward to being active in a local church and continuing to disciple the men and women the Lord puts in our lives. As a Vietnam veteran, Timothy has a strong desire to minister to those who have special needs as a result of their military experiences. He also hopes to do some pulpit supply.



While the future and the opportunities for continued ministry are exciting, we remain grounded in the present and we are committed to finishing this season well. Right now we are as busy or busier than we've ever been and the challenges are great. But it is so exciting to see how God is working, and we sense that these final months on the field will be more productive than any other time in our lives. We want to thank you for your partnership over the years, and ask that you continue in partnership with us as we prepare to pass the baton here in Mindanao. Our deepest desire is that when we step aboard that plane in Manila on July 2nd, we will leave behind fruit that will remain—fruit that will multiply and produce a great harvest. Above all, we pray that the lives we've had the opportunity to touch will grow deep in their faith and will impact the world around them with the hope and the transforming grace and power of the Lord Jesus Christ.

PRIORITY PRAYER REQUESTS FOR TIMOTHY & GLORIA

- This is a challenging and demanding time as we pass the baton of leadership. Pray that we will have wisdom, strength, and health and that this transition will go smoothly as we transfer ministry responsibilities.

Already some of our support has been dropped or reduced because of our approaching retirement. After March 1, 2013, we will still require some support to fund our ongoing part-time ministry with WorldVenture.
- Pray for our Hope Mountain staff and board during this time of transition. Pray especially for Mike Miguel as he takes over as Manager after the Annual Corporate Board Meeting March 24.
