
From

Tim and Pat are former missionaries with YWAM in Greece and the Philippines.



Doug Schipull, KC9OMS







Dear Partners in Ministry,
Greetings from warm Mindanao!

As time continues to fly by and we move closer and closer to our return to the United States, we increasingly realize how vitally important it is for us to be able to communicate clearly the process we're going through and how the Lord is directing us to serve Him in this next chapter of our lives. Because many churches and individuals have invested sacrificially to enable us to serve the Lord as missionaries in this part of the world, we want make sure that everyone understands the details.

Again, we want to express our appreciation to you, as a faithful partner with us in ministry for many years. Your prayers and sacrificial giving has enabled the Lord's work here in the Philippines to move forward and we rejoice in seeing many lives touched with the transforming power of the Gospel. The Lord is good!

We realize that in any of life's major transitions that the details are not all revealed at once. We have been in regular communications with Dr. Marty Shaw, our Asian Director, Dave Childers, WorldVenture's North Central Region Team Leader, and WorldVenture leadership in Littleton. WorldVenture has asked both of us to continue in ministry on a part-time basis after our retirement from full-time missionary service on **March 1, 2013**. We've attached a **Special Update Newsletter** with more information concerning our transition and prayer needs. The ministry we will be stepping into has the potential of greatly expanding the Lord's work around the world as a new generation of missionaries are passed the baton. We are seeing the Lord raise up young people who are deeply committed to God's Word and the expansion of His kingdom in a very fragmented, unstable and hopeless world, and we're thankful that WorldVenture has asked us to be part the process of preparing these young Christians to impact the world with *the only hope, the transforming power of Jesus Christ*. We are excited about our future assignment in the U.S. because this will enable us to use our many past experiences as missionaries in coaching potential missionary candidates, help mission appointees prepare for living overseas, and work with local churches through mission training.

Please keep us in prayer as we continue to serve the Lord in the Philippines and make preparations to serve Him in the U.S.
