THEY'RE AT THE STARTING GATE

In recent weeks we've been watching a dream for the Blaan people beginning to unfold. In our last few letters, we've mentioned this, but now it's beginning in earnest. Like horses at the starting gate, the Blaans are excited to begin. On October 20th, 68 pastors and



lay workers from both Blaan dialects came together to set the ground work for translating the Old Testament into the Blaan language.

The meeting was held in General Santos City, southern Mindanao. This was the town near where Sally and Kathy worked for many years.

There was balance as the participants represented five different denominations. This is good as it insures the finished Bible will be accepted by the general Blaan community.

The next seminar will cover basic translation procedures and will be five days long—no date yet. Please pray for

the Blaans as they begin to work together. They have asked for prayer on what to do about the expenses. We feel they need to encourage the local churches to get involved in prayer and financial participation. Since the new Bible will be used by the Blaan church, they have a mandate from God to help those doing the work.

The vision is to see Blaan individuals and communities transformed by the power of God. The meeting ended up with Pastor Cuma Saya thanking God for the meeting and asking His help to make the project a reality.




After the presentations, there was a time for small groups to meet.


