Assisting K. Blaen Pastors to Teach Non-Readers

As you receive this letter, Lord willing, we are arriving in the Philippines for the start of a 16-day ministry time. We are excited about being back with our colleagues but especially about being with Blaen friends again.

Our purpose in going began two years ago on our last visit. We laid the groundwork then for the recording and duplication of the audio Koronadal Blaen New Testament. We are heading back to help train pastors to use the audio players most effectively, especially for marginal- and non-readers. We will be working with Raymond Francisco, the Philippines representative of Faith Comes by Hearing (FCbH). Fifty of the specially set-up "Proclaimer" Bible players are in the Philippines ready to hand out to participating pastors who will be using them in Bible studies in Blaen churches.

Pastor Cuma, who was the main facilitator for the hymn-writing workshop, has been organizing the Bible player training. He has arranged all the travel and venue for the workshop.

Now it's up to us and the FCbH representative. Pray for the workshop that will begin on July 12th.

We also hope to begin discussions on the translation of the Old Testament for the Koronadal Blaen people.
