Nick has talked to the county about the possibility of using the Madison county building located south of Norfolk. Dave, WBOYXH, suggested a location at NECC. Dave also offered the use of the land behind his shop. This site was favorably discussed by the group. Mike, Dave, Fred, and Nick will work out the details and report back to the group.

Fred announced the Nebraska QSO Party April 28 - 29, starting 6:00 AM Saturday through Noon on Sunday. Fred reported that Dave Thege is in the hospital in Sioux City (Mercy General). He will be there for at least another week. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
