Dave had a deep, resonant voice and fancied himself as a top notch New York radio announcer. His idol was Stuart Metz, an announcer for WCBS in New York (and a ham), and he frequently made announcements imitating Stu's diction and expressions.

I only knew Dave briefly as we crossed paths at W2DSC, but I am sad that I missed the chance to say hello again after so many years.
