C2C 2000 Event Rules & Procedures

1. Dates and times:

15 April 2000, 1300 UTC through 16 April 2000, 0500 UTC.

Participating clubs work maximum of 16 hours. Not all Clubs will be on for the entire contest!

2. Bands:

80, 40, 20, 15, and 10 (Includes Novice sub-bands). No use of the WARC bands. Clubs will call near FISTS frequencies.

3. Calling Procedures:

- a. Participating Club Stations will call CQ C2C or CQ CTC
- b. Exchange RST, Name, State/Province or country and FISTS numbers
- c. If QRP or Mobile, so state and log this info. (Possible endorsements to certificates pending)

4. Scoring:

Contacts with participating club stations will count toward normal FISTS awards, 3 points per such contact. Certificates will be awarded by the event organizers to all applicants who furnish log excerpts (NO QSL cards, please) and appropriate funds, showing contacts with:

5 Club Stations = Bronze Certificate 10 Club Stations = Silver Certificate 15 Club Stations = Gold Certificate

5. Application for Award Certificates:

U.S. Applicants must include \$3.00 U.S. (Check or M.O.)

DX Applicants must include \$5.00 U.S. (International M.O. or other instrument, payable in U.S. funds) Certificate fees include 1st Class Postage. Certificates will be posted flat in stiffened envelopes. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks from time your application is received.

6. QSL-Logging Procedures:

All participating clubs stations will handle their own logging and QSLs.
Log Club callsign, date and time (UTC), frequency, RST (Sent and Received) and FISTS Numbers. If either station is mobile or QRP, include this info in all QSLs and log entries.
Address all QSLs to Club contacted only, via FISTS QSL Bureau.
