Thanks to all those AVERT members that were able to support the events this past year. We supported the KIOWA helicopter fly-in and the All-Hands Meeting. Team members also

supported a couple of hazardous material events. Members have been getting basic emergency training throughout the year with continuing company support being forecast. Power Alert response training was started this past summer when we were within 15 minutes of having Anaheim Power shutting off our power due to a Stage 3 alert. AVERT members will be used to provide help with building evacuations and any emergency communications.

A special thanks to Steve Freeland for helping organize the events and making sure the weekly roll-calls are conducted. I want to also thank the Net control operators that run the weekly roll-calls.

As the Anaheim Host Disaster Preparedness Team lead I have had to call upon AVERT members more and more for support. I see this continuing. Beginning January 1, 2001 I will become the manager of a new department (115), which will be dedicated to disaster preparedness. Both AVERT and the Radio Club will have key roles.

Lastly, I would like to thank Dan Violette for coordinating the Radio Club move.
