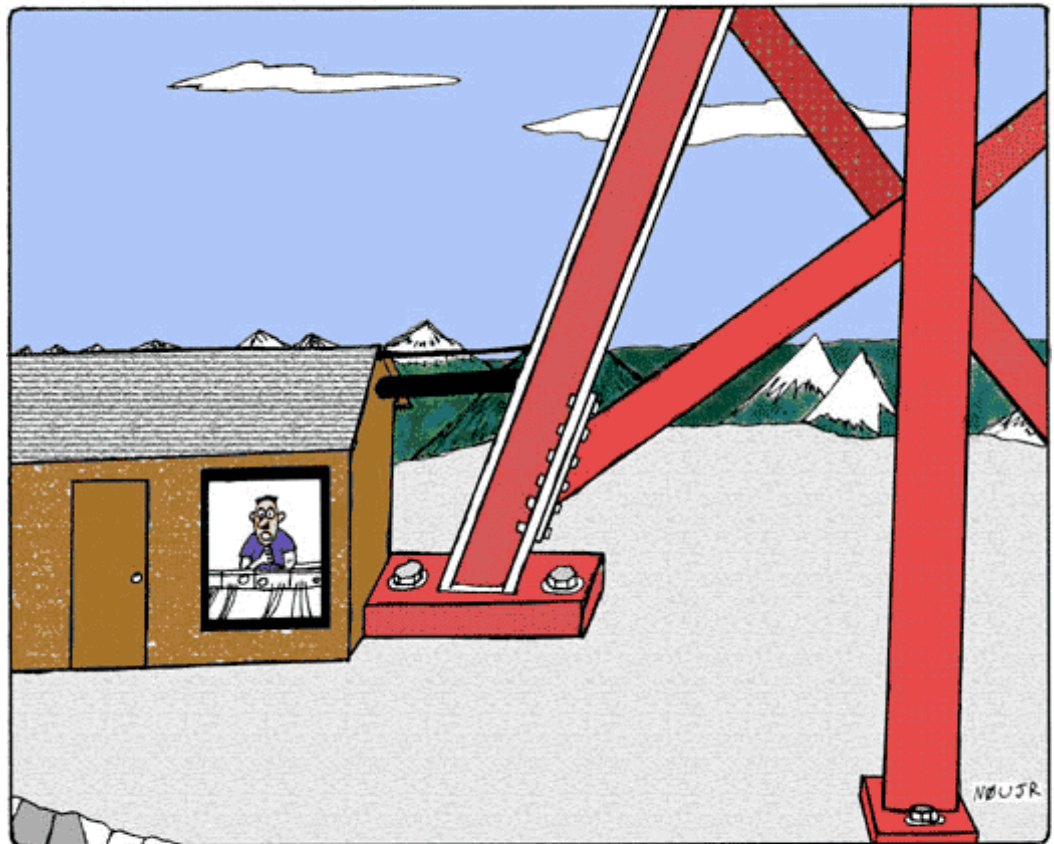
## *Name the Newsletter*
