7 - Hap reminded the membership to send him a list of their equipment and frequency capabilities.

8 - Some abbreviations and things to note that we need to become familiar with are the following:

ICP: Incident Command Post (Recognized by a green light)

EOC: Emergency Operations Center (Elected officials headquarters where decisions are made)

Helibase: Helicopter base

Helispot: Place for helicopters to land

HAZMAT: Hazardous materials

Net Control: Reports to finance section

Unity of Command: Everyone has one supervisor

Remember to register when you arrive at the scene. Check in and check out with the liaison officer.
