1) Meeting called to order at 6:14 pm by Nina

2) Public Comments – non-agenda items

A) Gordon reported that while waiting on Commerce Avenue, near Greeley, for a period of approximately ½ hour, witnessed six (6) drug transactions. The dealers congregated on Samoa and Greeley. The clients parked on Commerce Avenue and Kits rode bicycles down to the parked customers to make the transactions. This occurred on Monday, 05/05/08, starting at approximately 7:00 p.m. Gordon to call Tujunga Senior Lead, Officer Wall, and the Foothill Division main telephone number to report the activity. He will also ask that the VST unit be advised.

B) Two brush fires were recently started on Day Street, possibly by use of weed wackers. All people are admonished to use extreme caution with any gardening tool that can create sparks by hitting rocks or with the overall use of the product.

A) Q-Star camera – No report as there are no members in attendance of the committee formed in March to research use in the community. However, CD2 Wendy Greuel has offered to fund 50% of a camera cost for the community. STNC would be asked to fund 50% of the camera cost. Report provided of Q-Star manufacturer presentation at March STNC meeting. Susan made a motion to request funding from the STNC for the purchase of one camera, approximate cost \$3,500. Sue Ellen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Nina will advise Ms. Greuel's office the Safety Committee purchase recommendation and take the request to the STNC agenda meeting. Location use to be determined at a later date.

B) First Aid/CPT class at Elks Lodge scheduled for 05/03/08 was cancelled due to not meeting the requirement of 20 attendees. Nina to check with Stacy (LAFD) for rescheduling in August 2008. If the listing of last year's class attendees can be provided, Susan to contact those people to advise that their CPR card will be expiring in August of this year.

C) CERT class at Elks Lodge is in progress.
