<u>BIACK RACES MAP NOTEBOOKS</u> – They were handed out. Still need approx. 4 more for members. Will have by the next meeting.

SIERRA LAKES FIRE RACES DEPLOYMENT - The deployment on Oct 21 2007 was discussed. All were thanked who responded for doing a great job assisting PD and Fire. Radio dispatching worked very well to RACES units in the field until a stuck mic tied up and timed out the repeater, knocking communications out for a significant time period. RACES members were cautioned to be aware of their mic buttons and to check

periodically to make sure they don't have a stuck mic. It was decided if the repeater goes down or there is a stuck mic again during an activation, all RACES members will switch to the primary simplex freq or Channel 1 on your preprogrammed radio. Members need to remember to relay if we use simplex. A Radio Procedure Policy will be developed and distributed in the near future.

BONNY'S DEPT BASE STATION - It was discussed that Bonny Faulkner's Base station needs to be programmed for Channel 1 or the Primary simplex freq. She will contact RACES members to assist her in doing this.

<u>CHRISTMAS PARTY</u> - Bonny brought up that we need a Christmas Party for RACES. All agreed. Bonny and Tronaas to work on location and a date and time for the party in January. Party will be held at a restaurant.

ANOTHER BIG THANK YOU! – To those that responded and went with Lt. Tronaas in the Command Post to the Safety Fair at Vista Metals in Fontana on Oct 17.

CERT EPILETS – Discussed. RACES members only wear on RACES shirts, not there Crime Prevention shirts if you are a member of both.

HAM RADIO CLASS – To be held in January for Technicians. Date to be announced. RACES members to start studying now for upgrading license also! This class will be 3 – 2 hour sessions and a 1 hour test night to follow. Bonnie suggested having a GENERAL CLASS. Taken under advisement and may occur in near future after Tech Class.

<u>NET NIGHT</u> – Net night discussed. Rotation decided upon for now. The rotation will be Tina, Bonny, Sherry, Bill and Dave H starting Nov 15 with Tina.

EOC SETUP/ COMMUNICATIONS RACES DRILL – This was discussed and the date of JAN. 12 at 0900 hours were selected as the drill date. Tronaas to reserve EOC room. The EOC will be setup, the command post manned and at least 3 field radio stations will be set up in the drill and communications established and messages passed. BBQ or lunch will be served after or during drill.

RADIO INVENTORY – Cliff to forward copy of RACES radio inventory to Tronaas as soon as possible.

<u>KAISER HOSP. RADIO SITUATION</u> – This was briefly discussed. Kaiser Hospital's radio capabilities were examined by Dave Beaton, Joan Geist and Lt Tronaas on Oct 22nd. Their capabilities were woefully inadequate and it was communicated to our group that their management was not and would not support dedication of an area for a full time set up radio station. So as it is now, It is keep in two separate areas and is a pain to setup with no dedicated space and no plans to ever dedicate any space. The Drs. are in ego battles over an emergency radio group getting started over at the hospital. It was discussed and determined that RACES would most likely have to respond members down to the hospital and set up a radio station for communications during times of a disaster. This will be incorporated into the radio plan.

<u>SEMS/NIMS TRAINING</u> – Tronaas discussed upcoming training for RACES members. Would like RACES members to be trains in SEMS, NIMS 100, 200 and 700. Tronaas brought up NIMS courses are on the internet. Certificates will be mailed to you by FEMA if you complete the on line courses. First module will start in the Dec meeting of 3 modules on SEMS, the Calif. Emergency Management System. A test will be given after the three modules are completed over the next three meetings.

<u>LEVELS OF CERT</u> – It was briefly discussed that we will soon be putting out different criteria for levels of CERT and or RACES, and what the requirements will be. SEMS and NIMS training will be a part of attaining a higher level of RACES/ CERT.

ARRL TRAINING – Tina volunteered to do some ARRL training on messaging. This will also be given in the very near future at a RACES meeting.

EOC RADIO ROOM DAY – I will be contacting the members involved in the final install of radios in the radio room soon to select a day to finish the radio job.
