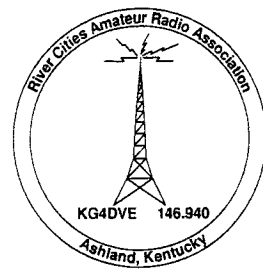




Minutes River Cities Amateur Radio Association March 3, 2009
