Amateur Assignments

Rest Stops

- 1) Call net control when you get to your assignment. **Be on time.**
- 2) Find person or persons in charge of your rest stop. Introduce yourself and let them know you will be providing communications for them.
- 3) Find a spot that will give you the best visibility up and down the road.
- 4) When the ambulance is staged at your rest stop, walk over and introduce yourself. You will provide backup communications to them should their radios fail.
- 5) When you call net control, use assignment number or where you are located.
- 6) Call net control if you will be off the air for any reason.

Middle

- 1) Call net control when you get to your assignment. **Be on time.**
- 2) You will be the only one there in charge of area between rest stops. Stay alert!
- 3) Find a spot that will give you the best visibility up and down the road.
- 4) When you call net control, use assignment number or where you are located.
- 5) Call net control if you will be off the air for any reason.

Start

- 1) Call net control when you get to your assignment. **Be on time.**
- 2) Find person or persons in charge of the start. Introduce yourself and let them know you will be providing communications for them.
- 3) Find a spot that will give you the best visibility up and down the road.
- 4) When you call net control, use assignment number or where you are located.
- 5) Call net control if you will be off the air for any reason.

Finish
