- Optional opportunity for your club to provide seed money for the next ARRL (LA Area) Southwestern Division Convention includes, participating in the planning and share in the profits.

We meet six times a year, on the first Tuesday of every other month. Meetings are held in the Los Angeles Maritime Museum, Birth 84 foot of 6 Street in San Pedro California.
