APRIL 18, 2023

He also passed the time working as 4U1UN during the ARRL CW contest.

Adrian then commented that the 3Y0J team will return some of the donations that were made to their DXpedition.

There was a general discussion about using FT8 on 6 meters. Bob, W2OSR, said that he has been having problems decoding on 160.

For the entertainment part of the evening, John, W2GW, showed a video of the 1997 DXpedition to Heard Island, VK0IR. The operators made over 80,000 QSOs during harsh weather conditions.
