



Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service “EOB” Net Control for Summer 2020 Communication Exercise



5 MINUTES BEFORE THE EXERCISE: (0825 Hours)

This is (*personal callsign*) A test drill for the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service will be start on this frequency in five minutes at 0830 hours and continue intermittently until approximately 1100 hours. The cooperation of all amateurs on this frequency for the duration of the drill will be greatly appreciated.

This is (*Operator's Tac Call, operator's callsign*), clear until 0830 hours.

OPENING THE EXERCISE: (0830 Hours)

This is (*personal callsign*) net control station of the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service.

This frequency will be in use intermittently until 1100 hours during a test drill for members of the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service. Only registered DCS members may be recognized by this net control station. There is no actual emergency, this is only a test exercise.

This operator is (*tactical call*).

[Repeat OPENING THE EXERCISE announcement every 10 minutes until Check Ins from members begin]

TAKING CHECK-INS FROM DCS MEMBERS, ALL DISTRICTS: (0930-1015 Hours)

This is (*personal callsign*) net control station of the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service. DCS members please check in with your Unit ID, amateur call, and city when called by District. Please advise if you have a voice message in place of using NBEMS. There will be opportunities for late or missed check ins.

Stations from Districts 2, 3/17, or 4 come now:
(*Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID*)

Stations from Districts 5, 6, or 8/29 come now:
(*Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID*)

Stations from Districts 9 or 11/26 come now:
(*Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID*)

Stations from Districts 12, 13, or 14 come now:
(*Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID*)

Stations from Districts 15, 16, or 18 come now:
(Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID)

Any stations from District 22 come now:
(Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID)

Any stations from Districts 95 or SCC come now:
(Continue calling until none remain, then NCO callsign ID)

Repeat above cycle until 1015 hours

CLOSING THE EXERCISE: (1030 Hours)

This is (*personal callsign*) net control station of the Los Angeles County Operational Area Disaster Communications Service. The cooperation of all amateurs on this frequency during the test exercise just completed has been greatly appreciated. The frequency is clear at 1030 hours. This is (*tactical call, personal callsign*) clear.
