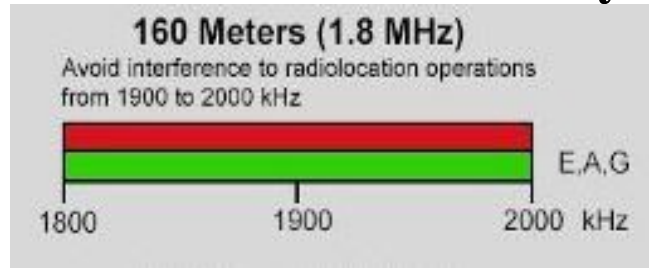


160 Meter Band

“Top Band” as it's more commonly referred to.



160 Meters (1.8-2.0 MHz)

| 1.999 - 2.000 | Beacons |

Lowest band in Amateur Radio and uses the longest antenna.

An ½ wave dipole equals 260' of wire.

Yielding 130' per dipole leg at 1.800 MHz.
