A five session **Extra Class License Course** will be conducted by the Raleigh Amateur Radio Society. You must have a General Class license in order to take the Extra Class license exam.

When: Oct 4, 11, 18, 25, Nov 1. The sessions will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end around 12:30 p.m.

Where: Raleigh, NC. Specific location will be provided upon pre-registration.

**Volunteer Instructor:** Mike Murphy, WA4BPJ, has an Extra Class license and has been teaching since the 1970s and has conducted as many as 60 courses. In addition to this course, he also teaches the Technician and Extra courses.
