Amateur Radio **Extra Class** License Course Raleigh Amateur Radio Society

Original Announcement Date: August 10, 2015

A seven session **Amateur Extra Class License Course** will be conducted by the Raleigh Amateur Radio Society. To earn a specific license, one must pass that level exam plus pass all exams below that level. In this case, the Technician Class and General Class exams must be passed in addition to passing the Amateur Extra Class exam in order for the Amateur Extra Class license to be awarded.

When: Oct 3, 10, 17, 24, 31, Nov 7, 14. The sessions will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end around 12:30 p.m. <u>Please note</u> that this course will not be offered again until this time next year.

Where: Raleigh, NC. Specific location will be provided upon pre-registration.

Volunteer Instructor: Mike Murphy, WA4BPJ, has an Extra Class license and has been teaching since the 1970s and has conducted as many as 60 courses. In addition to this course, he also teaches the Technician and Extra courses.

Fee: The fee is \$10.00 (payable at the first session)

Course Text: The required manual is the current edition of: **The ARRL Ham Radio License Manual – Level 3, Extra Class License Manual, 10th Edition (ISBN: 978-0-87259-517-0)** (good until 2016-06-30 – we won't be doing another Extra course before then) and is available online (i.e. ARRL, Amazon, etc.).

Examination: An **optional** examination is scheduled for the afternoon of the last session for the convenience of the students. This is done by a separate group of RARS Volunteer Examiners and there is a separate fee.

Pre-Registration: E-mail me **your phone number and call sign**. A registration form and other details will be e-mailed to you.

Hi to the Cary ARC Inc (N4NC) and its Members:

This is to invite the Cary ARC Inc (N4NC)and its members to participate in the 2015 US Islands QSO Party on August 29-30 (1200-0300 UTC). Nearly 3000 islands have been listed by the 21 year old US Islands Award Program and a little more than 2000 of these have been activated. There are many more islands in the USA and its territories that qualify for listing since an Island only need to be surrounded by water, at least 100 feet long and at least 50 feet from the main shoreline.

A mini-expedition to activate an island can be a fun club or individual Ham experience. This is especially true during USI's Spring One-Day Getaway and the August QSO Party. Being on the receiving end of relaxed pile-ups along with QSOs with other island stations and an expanding band of island collectors can be a rewarding activity for N4NC. Some QSO Party island expeditions will be to previously activated Islands while others will be activating listed but not yet activated islands or new islands they have had added to the list.

The first reported activators of an island have their callsign shown on the list of US Islands. Initial activations require at least 25 QSOs and contacts with at least two DX entities (usually the US and one other), but subsequent activations can be as few or many QSOs as you want to make.

Participating non-island stations are an important part of the USI QSO Party, so if Cary ARC Inc will not be operating from an island please consider having N4NC contact the island stations during the USI QSO Party.
