Filming has begun...

There are to be a number of UHF (460-band) frequencies I've tried to figure them out **Production Crew:**

R = repeater, S=simplex, **R**/s = may be used either way

Ch 1 - 464.55s - Primary (big-shots & "calling" frequency)

- Ch 2 464.75_{R/S} (called "Channel 16" when using their portable repeater)
- Ch 3 461.8625s Transportation
- Ch 4 461.0875s -

Ch 5 - 461.8875s - Location/Security & Police/CHP officers

Ch ? - 461.6875_s -

They talk about channels numbered all the way from 1 to 17, these are all I've found searching the 461-470 band in 12.5 khz steps. Channels 1 -5 plus 467.80 have been busiest

Wireless Microphones (where the REAL action is)

The first three are adjacent to TV Channel 4 and may be different in other areas - and many scanners can't receive these freqs. Also, these are very low power, usually 1/20th watt maximum. Their receiving antennas are generally mounted on metal poles in the street as close as possible to the set being used

72.90 MHz - Sound & camera techs, some actors when shooting
75.90 '' - Same, <u>but very best ''live action''</u> during actual speaking parts
73.81 '' - non-standard freq, may just be an ''image'' of one of the above
