SITUATION AS YOU SEE IT:

Voice Repeaters Down: ALL VOICE REPEATERS ARE UNUSABLE.
(Including SARNET)

SIMPLEX REPEATER EMPLACEMENT

CONSIDER SENDING A TEAM TO EMPLACE A SIMPLEX REPEATER AT A HIGH LOCATION. IT IS MIDNIGHT. THEY WILL NEED TO WORK IN THE DARK USING FLASHLIGHTS. IF THERE ARE NO FLASHLIGHTS...THEN YOU CAN'T SET UP A SIMPLEX REPEATER. POSSIBLE SITES INCLUDE:

A) THE ARCHER ROAD SIDE STAIRWELL OF THE SHANDS SOUTH TOWER AT THE

LEVEL OF THE HELIPAD. THIS AREA IS USUALLY COMPLETELY DESERTED. PLEASE DISCONTINUE TRANSMITTING IF YOU SEE A HELICOPTER ABOUT TO LAND AT EITHER SHANDS HELIPORT (THERE IS A VERY RARE RISK OF INTERFERENCE TO THEIR AM TRANSCEIVERS ON THE AIRCRAFT BAND)

B) THE 11TH FLOOR NORTH FACING WINDOW OF THE DENTAL TOWER JUST OUTSIDE THE DENTAL OFFICES....IF IT IS A WEEKEND.....THIS LOCATION ISN'T A GOOD CHOICE ON A WEEKDAY DUE TO NORMAL DAILY TRAFFIC.

C) THE TOP FLOOR OF ANY SHANDS PARKING LOT THAT IS LEGAL TO UTILIZE (E.G. THE PATIENT PARKING LOT NEXT TO THE MEDICAL PLAZA) OR ANY OTHER PATIENT PARKING LOT. ON A WEEKDAY YOU WILL NEED TO PAY \$10 TO EXIT; A \$10 BILL IS ENCLOSED TO COVER THAT COST. IF THIS IS YOUR PLAN SUGGEST TO USE A VEHICLE WITH AN ACCESSIBLE ROOF TOP ANTENNA AND CONNECT IT TO THE SIMPLEX REPEATER BEFORE TURNING THE REPEATER TRANSCEIVER ON.

TEST EXERCISE MESSAGE

HURRICANE ARES HAS NOW PAST AND SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE IS REPORTED. WIDESPREAD POWER OUTAGES WITHIN ALACHUA COUNTY. DEERHAVEN REPORTS SIGNIFICANT POWER GENERATION ISSUES. UNCONFIRMED REPORTS OF SIGNIFICANT ISSUE WITHIN SOUTH TOWER OF SHANDS HOSPITAL. INTERNET TELEPHONE AND CELL SERVICE FAILED/FAILING WITHIN ALACHUA COUNTY. TRUNKED RADIO PUBLIC SYSTEM FAILING. POLICE ARE MONITORING CB CHANNEL 12 FOR COMMAND AND CONTROL; FIRE DEPT MONITORING CB CHANNEL 15 FOR COMMAND AND CONTROL; CITIZENS ARE ABLE TO USE CHANNEL 9 TO REACH EMERGENCY HELP.

I75 IS BLOCKED AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS BY TORNADO BLOWN DEBRIS AND EMERGENCY PERSONNEL ARE ATTEMPTING TO CLEAR.

TORNADO PATH APPARENTLY INCLUDED TV TOWERS INCLUDING AMATEUR RADIO REPEATERS.

HURRICANE ARES CENTER NOW LOCATED 50 MILES EAST OF MIAMI FLORIDA. WINDS IN NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA NOW E25MP GUSTING TO 35MPH. OVERCAST SKIES , RAIN BANDS STILL MOVING THROUGH. PRECIPITATION WITHIN LAST 24 HOURS 8 INCHES; EXPECT 1 MORE INCH THROUGHOUT REMAINDER OF THIS DAY, MODERATING WINDS.

SEND ONE VEHICLE EQUIPPED WITH ALL NECESSARY COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR VOICE AND DIGITAL COMMUNICATIONS.		

IF SATURDAY PROCEED WITH PORTABLE ANENNA TO 11TH FLOOR DENTAL WING NORTH FACING PICTURE WINDOW OUTSIDE DENTAL OFFICES, AN AREA WHICH SHOULD BE DESERTED.
