ALL ABOUT THE BOOK THAT LEW WROTE

My brother, Bill, was on the USS Phoenix during the attack on Pearl Harbor. He died later during the war from tuberculosis contacted in the South Pacific. Finishing high school, college, marriage, work, family, I thought of him but was always very busy. I remembered waving good by to him on June 16, 1941 the last time I saw him alive. After I retired I became curious about my brother and his experiences in the Navy. I found four men that knew him and I found his girl friend in Australia after 54 years.

The Phoenix was sold to Argentina in 1951. The British sank the Phoenix/Belgrano during the Falkland Island War in 1982. I have met a veteran of the Belgrano from Argentina and have his story of the sinking. I correspond with a sailor on the submarine that sank the Belgrano. And then six years ago I went to Japan to meet personally two aviators who participated in the attack on Pearl Harbor.

The story of my brother, Bill, leaving home, his letters, etc., and the men who followed have all come together in a book, "Brothers of War."
