FROM KLAMATH BASIN SENIOR CITIZENS' COUNCIL NEWS LETTER: Nice to know, an E mail from LouEllen Kelly: To really make scrambled eggs or omelets rich, add a couple of spoonfuls of sour cream, cream cheese or heavy cream to them and then bet them up.---- Add a teaspoon of water when frying ground beef. It will help pull the grease away from the meat while cooking.---To warm biscuits, pancakes or muffins that have been refrigerated, place them in a microwave with a cup of water. The increased moisture will keep the food moist and help it reheat faster.-  
---To keep squirrels from eating your plants, sprinkle your plants with cayenne pepper. The cayenne pepper doesn't hurt the plant and the squirrels won't come near it.----If you seal an envelope and then realize you forgot to include something inside, just place your sealed envelope in the freezer for an hour or two.
