Activities Manager, Scott Larimer, KN4RPA, said the Fall Foliage Race needs 3 more volunteers. The course of the race has changed because of low rainfall. The race will be on October 14.

Scott needs some volunteers for the Marine Corps Marathon in Washington on Sunday, October 29.

The RVARC will support the Turkey Trot on November 23 (Thanksgiving) and the Blue and Gray Half Marathon of December 3. There was a discussion about supporting the Girls On The Run race on November 12 at the Fredericksburg Nationals stadium.

Randy Shrader, KM4HFB, made a motion to donate \$500 to the sheriff Office. The motion was approved.

The date of October 28 was set for the Jim Steele Memorial Tailgate Party, at the Marquee Cinemas.
