SCCARA BOARD MEETING MINUTES, 11/17/88 at S.J. RED CROSS.

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by V.P. Bob Forster, N6PCQ.

Present: V.P.Bob, N6PCQ; Treas. Dan, WM6M; Directors: Ed, WD6CHD; Bob, N6KLQ; Lou, WA6QYS. Also present were Treas-elect Kathy, KB6ICQ and Stan, WA6VJY.

Absent: Pres. Allen, N6NOY; Secty Le, KB6MXH; Directors: Art, KG6PY; and Herb, KB6ABG.

Treas. Dan reported a then current balance of \$1,482.43 from which the following bills were to be paid after approval: \$34.67 for SCCARA-GRAM printing; \$56.11 for drawing prizes; \$41.28 for trailer parts; \$26.24 due Wohlers for equipment insurance; \$493 1989 liability insurance; \$25. due DMV for trailer license. was to review equipment coverage to insure all equipment included, updating as necessary. Bills were Board also pre-approved approved. table decorations and a case of wine as prizes for Xmas Party. Dan also showed the Board SCCARA's portfolio of AT&T/PT&T Stock Certificates, recomending that a Safe-Deposit Box be obtained by the incoming Treasurer as a part of the new account package.
