The MLA award series began in 1967 as a Centennial Project when special 3B and 3C prefixes were authorized by the Department of Communications for Canada. To date more than two thousand certificates and almost three award plaques have been awarded to amateurs around the world. Today, the attractive red flag design is printed on beige parchment and details about the certificate and applicant are printed originally by computer and inkjet printer.

The award is issued in different classes as follows for the flag certificate:

Send log data and/or complete the chart.
(See over or separate sheet for the template.)

Class V	requires	05 prefixes
Class IV	requires	10 prefixes
Class III	requires	15 prefixes
Class II	requires	25 prefixes
Class I	requires	30 prefixes

Do NOT send QSL cards. The Maple Leaf Radio Society reserves the right to check on any claimed contact/QSL.
