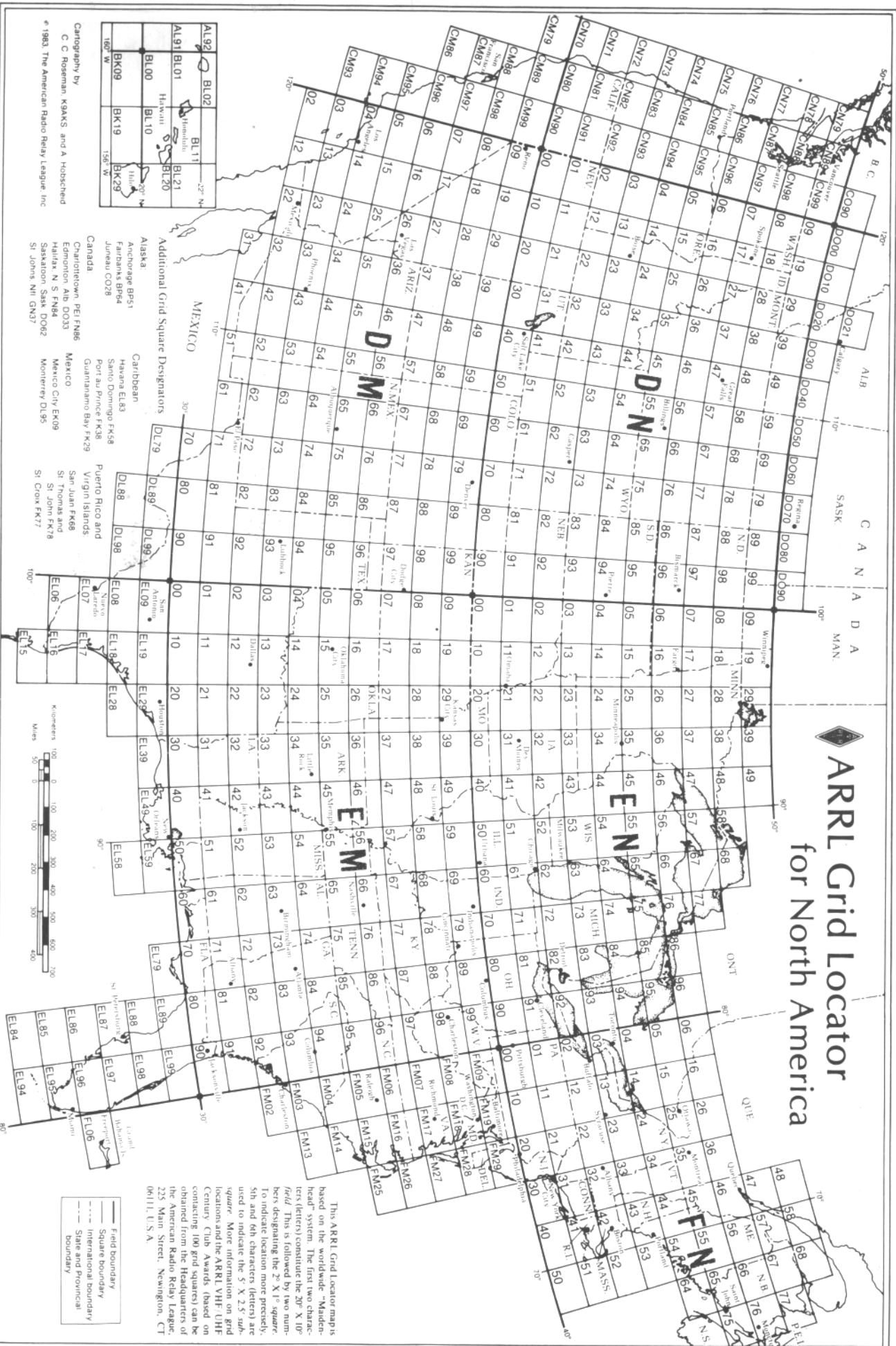


ARRL Grid Locator for North America



This ARRL Grid Locator map is based on the worldwide " Maidenhead" system. The first two characters (letters) constitute the 20° X 10° field. This is followed by two numbers designating the 2° X 1° square. 5th and 6th characters (letters) are used to indicate the 5' X 2.5' sub-square.
