- **Open 2 meter repeater with autopatch** – and periodic club announcements (146.70 MHz (-), no tone).
- **Open 70 cm repeater** – operational since 2004 (448.90 MHz (-), no tone).
- **IRLP & Echolink simplex repeater** – 144.355 MHz (100 Hz tone). Contact BARC70@arrl.net for more information.
- **D-Star Repeaters** – currently under development for use on 1.2 GHz, 70 cm and 2 meters.
- **Remotely operated HF station** – operate from anywhere using a remote TS-480S and 165' tall tower and antennas.
- **BARC's Bark newsletter** -- monthly issue with interesting news, features, projects and club announcements.
- **Monthly meetings with programs** -- third Tuesday of each month (except January & July), 7:00 p.m., at the new BARC Clubroom, Boulder Municipal Airport, 3335 Airport Rd. (lower level, enter by northwest door).
- **Annual picnic and dinner** -- July picnic at a local park and January dinner at a local restaurant.
- **BARC Juniors** -- serving the community for over 18 years by helping ("Elmering") young people to spread the hobby to the next generation. More than 180 young local hams have been licensed.
- **Scholarship award** -- given annually to an undergraduate university radio amateur. Donations welcome.
- **Weekly net** -- held every Sunday at 7:00 p.m. on the BARC 2 meter repeater. Everyone welcome.
- **Monthly VE testing** -- first Thursday of each month, 7:00 p.m., at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 701 W. South Boulder Road (at Washington Street), Louisville. See BARC web site for additional details.
- **Technician & General classes** – held periodically to help new hams get licensed.
- **BARCfest** -- awesome annual swapfest held on the fourth Sunday of September, every year since 1953.
- **ARRL Field Day** – premier annual BARC Club event held at nearby mountain site. Operation typically earns nationwide contest scores in the top 10%, while also taking time to help new hams get on the air.
- **Public service activities** -- providing communications assistance for special events and emergency response in coordination with Boulder County Amateur Radio Emergency Services (BCARES).
