A WARNING ABOUT A RECENT PayPal EMAIL SCAM

What is PayPal? It's a service, now owned by Ebay, which allows a person with a PC to pay anyone with an email address by using his/her credit card. Someone, unfortunately, has found a way to scam PayPal participants into revealing their account numbers, passwords, etc., in order to steal their money.

If you receive an email from what seems to be PayPal, DO NOT go to the link and fill out the form and submit it. It's bogus and you'll be sending your confidential information to unknown persons.

Red flags to look for in such web pages: There is NO lock in the status bar of your browser. There is one on the page itself, but that too is bogus, just a lock icon shown at the top of the page. The page has you entering your email address, password, credit card and banking information onto a pop-up window BEFORE logging on to your account page. You should never be asked to enter credit card or banking information until you have actually logged into the PayPal website and are behind their website security. A legitimate email would have you log into their site, and then enter your information.

Here's an example of a typical BOGUS PayPal email message:

"Dear PayPal user, PayPal is constantly working to increase security for all of our users. To ensure the integrity of our payment network, we periodically review accounts. Your account will be placed on restricted status. Restricted accounts continue to receive payments, but are limited in their ability to send or withdraw funds. To lift this restriction, you need to complete our credit card verification process. At least one credit card in your account has

been unconfirmed, meaning that you may no longer send money with this or any other card until you have completed the credit card confirmation process. To initiate the credit card confirmation, please follow this link and fill in all necessary fields.

http://www.paypal.com/cgi-bin/webscr?cmd=_rav-form (The link looks like this, which would take you to a REAL, although outdated, PayPal link.

The link is actually http://211.47.191.125:199/cgi/index.htm, which takes you to the BOGUS site.)

If you receive this or a similar letter, don't click on the link. Instead forward the email with the complete header to spoof@paypal.com and they will investigate to see if it's bogus, and send you a reply. ■
