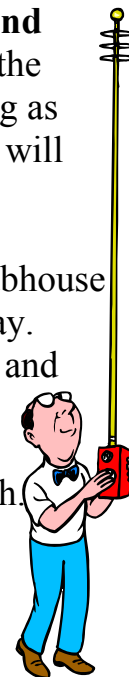

Old Business:

Repeater Report - Bill Dean reported there has been no technical activity on the repeaters in the past month, but Larry Thomas, Bill Lorenzo and Bill Dean mowed the grass at the 146.925 MHz repeater site. He said the grass was quite high.

ARES - Tom Oyer, Pike County Emergency Coordinator (EC), informed the membership that Pike County was forming an ARES group. He encouraged anyone wanting to join this group to sign up, especially those living in Pike County.

Tour of the Scioto River Valley (TOSRV) - Wayne Cook reported this year's tour was a challenge for bikers and amateur radio operators. Weather conditions included a little sun, wind, plenty of rain, thunderstorms, 1/2" hail, and high water. TOSRV sponsored a buffet dinner at the Pump House in Yoctangee Park for those operators who participated in the tour. Central Ohio ARES (COARES) thanked the Scioto Valley Amateur Radio Club frequently for permitting them to conduct a portion of the TOSRV net on our 146.850 MHz repeater.

Tom Oyer reported that Gary Stevens WW8O tried to contact him with emergency traffic on Saturday afternoon of TOSRV on the 146.850 MHz repeater. Gary told Tom that net control would not let him contact Tom on the 146.850 MHz repeater. At the time the repeater was being used by COARES to conduct a net in support of TOSRV. Tom requested that the situation be pursued to determine why the traffic did not get through to him. John Mann offered his assistance by getting in touch with Rich Jordan, of COARES, to inquire what information net control received and what action they took.

New Business:
