# SCIOTO VALLEY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB

## Minutes, Regular Meeting September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2003

1. Meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm with the Pledge to the Flag.
2. Termite Problem - Our clubhouse is infested with termites. They are living beneath the slab, building tunnels and eating the wooden parts of our clubhouse. Mr. Spetnagle of Spetnagle Pest Control, Chillicothe, Ohio, has inspected the clubhouse and proposed two methods of treatment.

The first proposal is to pull back the carpet about 6-inches along exterior walls, drill holes through the slab every 18" and pump poisoning liquid underneath the slab to kill the termites. After drilling the carpet would be put down again. Drilling will generate dust inside the clubhouse from the drilling. This treatment will cost \$1209.40.

The second proposal is to do proposal one and also place baits around the clubhouse exterior to kill termites around the perimeter of the building. The baits would be checked periodically and replenished with termite poison when required. This treatment will cost \$1715.75 and there may be additional costs for checking and replenishing the baits.

Treatment by bait alone will not immediately stop the termites eating the wood.

There is the possibility of drilling through the exterior wall below the slab to inject the poison beneath the slab but this depends on how the building is constructed.

We will seek another estimate of treating the clubhouse.
3. Motion by KC8VTP, 2nd by N8LSV, to dispense with the reading of the minutes. Motion carried.
4. Treasurer's Report prepared by Jim Anzelmo was presented to the membership. Motion by KC8VTP, 2nd by KC8BBT, to approve the report. Motion carried.
5. President Turner commented we may need to have a fish fry to help with termite elimination costs.
6. President Turner noted that a base has been poured for a new tower at the SW corner of the clubhouse.
7. 2m repeaters are working OK
8. Health and Welfare - Gladys Miller, Jackie Berry and Jack Thompson are out and about. T. J. Oyer has gotten some publicity in the Waverly News Watchman about amateur radio emergency services. in Pike County.
9. Steve Newland N8TUW has joined our club.
10. Refreshment Fund - Balance is \$102.07 plus about \$10.00 in the kitty.
11. Tom Oyer reported that Pike County ARES is working on an communication center at the Pike County Emergency Operations Center and on radios for a mobile EOC. Pike County ARES is meeting on the fourth Thursday of each month at the Pike County EOC located at the Pike County Airport.
12. Anticipation ran high as the 50-50 drawing drew near. Some were sitting on the edges of their chairs just waiting for their number to be drawn. Dick Hopper was elected to pick the numbers from the pot. First he drew one, then another with no one signed up for the numbers drawn. Then he drew the number assigned to Charles Drummond. Charles was very happy to win the pot and graciously donated \$3.00 of his winnings of \$4.00 back to the club. Thank you, Charlie!
13. Motion by KC8BBT, 2nd by KC8VTP, to adjourn. Motion carried, meeting adjourned at 8:40pm.
