Minutes of the August 26' 2015 CIRC Meeting

The The August 26, 2015 regularly scheduled meeting of CIRC was called to order by President, Grant Zehr (AA9LC) at 7:00 PM.

The President asked all members and guests to introduce themselves. It was noted that two guests, Jerry Parr (K7OU) of Phoenix, AZ and Doug Svitchen (N9IQT) of Bloomington, IL, were present.

Copies of the Minutes of the meetings of CIRC were recently distributed to members in the CIRC Newsletter which was made available on the Club reflector. On motion by Norm Huber (N9ZKS) and second by Keith Hanson (AC9S) the minutes of the July 2015 CIRC regular meeting were unanimously approved.

Treasurer Kathy Huber (KC9SKF) Presented the Treasurer's Report. The current checking balance was \$2,901.71. On motion by Dennis Mills (KE9UA) and second by Dick Dubroff (W9XW), the Treasurer's Report was unanimously accepted.

A discussion of Amateur Radio Parity Act was then held. It was noted that the ARRL was asking all members to contact their legislators expressing support for this Act. Mike Sallee (KC9FWL) indicated he would be happy to assist any CIRC member make the appropriate contact.

Grant indicated he had received the annual request from the State to renew its corporate documents this September. The current Secretary, Duane Benjamin (KC9PIM), indicated he would do this.

Norm Huber reminded everyone that the Peoria Superfest would be held from September 18 to 20. Norm has several advance tickets available for sale.

President Grant Zehr then discussed the current status of responsibility and authority for operation of club radio stations under the club's constitution and federal regulations. Grant read the full text of a Resolution of the CIRC Board of Directors that was approved at the August 24th 2015 meeting of the Board. The resolution restated that the ultimate responsibility for oversight and control of club radio stations was with the CIRC Board, with operational matters to be entrusted to Board appointed Trustees, and further required periodic reporting of all radio station and repeater activities to the membership.

It was noted that the Club did not elect a 2015-2016 member-at-large to the Board of Directors at the May 2015 meeting. On motion by Tom Planer (KJ9P) and second by Gary Huber (AB9M) it was moved that the May 2015 minutes be retroactively amended to indicate that Keith Hanson (AC9S) was elected to the position of 2015-2016 member-at-large to the Board of Directors.

Jim Baker (WB9GDL) gave a report on the success of the recent "Hop for Hope" that the club assisted with communication and related services. Jim passed on the thanks of the event sponsors to the club and members that participated.

It was noted that several of the club's events have resulted in requests for QSL cards. Tom Planer indicated he would make and donate a small supply of QSL cards for both W9EX and W9AML.

A discussion was held regarding the September 26, 2015 ¹/₂ Marathon to be run from the Eastview Christian Church to Downtown Normal. A manager for the Club's efforts is needed.

Gary Huber indicated there was an opportunity for any member that was interested in DXing to meet with several local experts and to learn, first hand, how to become more proficient in this portion of the amateur radio hobby. Interested individuals can contact him at <u>AB9M@ARRL.net</u>.

On motion by Tom Planer, seconded by Dennis Mills (KE9UA), the meeting was unanimously adjourned.
