Field Day 2004

Field day took a nostalgic turn back in time for the AADXA club as we "went back to our roots" and held Field Day 2004 on the Mr. Charlie oil rig museum in downtown Morgan City. Running 3 HF rigs in voice, CW, and digital (a first) on the Charlie itself. We competed in the 3A category gaining 321 contacts and 2124 points in the process. Murphy attacked with full force this year with antenna problems (with us mainly operating on bazooka dipole antennas and HF verticals) as well as power problems. After almost 4 hours of fighting Murphy back in the rain, we operated attack free for almost 16 hours non-stop. We actually stopped Field Day early this year as major rains were forecasted and we didn't want to be caught by the rains again.
