



## Western Oregon Radio Club

The **Western Oregon Radio Club** operates a system of linked repeaters in the Portland metropolitan area. The repeater sites are linked by radio to allow users to be heard on any of the repeaters from any of the other repeaters. This provides coverage of the entire metropolitan area with few shadowed areas. The **WORC** also operates an autopatch which is available to club members. The **WORC** repeaters are on the 6 meter, 2 meter, 1-1/4 meters, 70 centimeter and 23 centimeter bands. The **WORC** system participates in the **Evergreen Intertie System**.



The **Evergreen Intertie System** is a cooperative effort by the owners of 32 repeaters throughout the Pacific Northwest. The repeaters which are part of the Intertie are operated independently, but they may be connected to a radio trunk for communications out of a local area or during network operations. A repeater which is connected to a trunk may communicate with any other repeater connected to that trunk. Users of the Intertie send DTMF commands to system repeaters to connect or disconnect the system.
