It's time I step aside, to let fresh ideas lead the way into the next decade. Thank You for your support, within the club, and those outside the club.



## AGM AREC Report

2019 has been a good year for Branch 02 AREC with members participating in supporting the Tour de Ranges bicycle race, the Whangarei Rally, LandSAR communications as well as assisting Branch 65 with Maramarua Forest car rallys, Branch 29 with their Scouting Jamboree on the Air weekend and other events.

At a national level, AREC have recognised the need to provide training to members to both up-skill them as well as ensuring a consistent standard of operation is achieved. We expect that over the coming year, Branch 02 AREC members will have the opportunity to participate in training.

Within Auckland, the intention is to create a closer association across AREC groups - this will allow all of us to know what groups are up to and provide opportunities to take part in training and exercises run by our fellow Branches.

Also in Auckland, Auckland Emergency Management (Auckland Council Civil Defence) have recently signed and updated MOU with Auckland AREC for message handling across their region-wide VHF radio network. This requires AREC to provide trained, competent operators to key locations as well as supporting local Community Response Groups with setting up communications systems and plans to allow them to coordinate locally and report into the AEM network.

AEM have also offered training to AREC members on subjects such as first aid and CIMS2 and 4. These will all be free of charge and interested members should register their interest via myself.

Finally, I would like the thank Japie Nel (our previous Branch AREC Group Leader), Jim Smith (Deputy Branch Group Leader) and all of Branch 02's AREC members and supporters for their participation, and good humour across the year.

- Minutes: Previous General Meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2019 Minutes having been circulated, was approved ZL1WAL / ZL1GH
- Finance: Reimbursement \$474.00 (being over \$300) to Gwynne ZL1AAR for expenses to ferry two cars to Waiheke Island to pick up the radio gear given to the Branch by Warren ZL1AIX-SK.

#### **Reports:**

**Raffle /Subs:** The Branch subsidises early sub payments with a raffle ticket for the ARRL Handbook.

- Antennas: It was decided by the Committee not to sell the SteppIR DB36, but rather to mount it on the Nally tower instead. Another trip to Waiheke is planned to pick up the SteppIR and its control gear. The tri-band Yagi will be put back on top of the west pole.
- **Tenders:** The newsletter lists equipment that is available for sale by tender. Tenders will be opened at the Committee meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> Dec. Unsuccessful tenders will **not** be notified.
- **AGM:** The newsletter contains formal notice of the AGM to be held here in the clubroom on Tuesday evening 10<sup>th</sup> December 2019 starting at 1930 hours. Reports will be e-mailed out beforehand. Members are asked to come half an hour earlier to pick up brochures and learn about ICOM radios from Richard Bins and Mindy representing ICOM NZ RWB.
- Guidelines: Wallace advised that he has rewritten the document that he presented at the AGM last year, called "By-Laws". Bob ZL1AFU had suggested then that it should avoid repeating rules that are already contained in our Constitution. Accordingly, the motion was withdrawn and tabled for revision.
  The Committee is presently proof reading it and making suggestions for more items to be included. It will be circulated to Members before the AGM, so that their further suggestions can be heard. This document consolidates the decisions made by various Committees over the years. It will be useful to new members to guide them about our established practices. The meeting adjourned at 1355 hours for the presentation.
- **Speaker:** Wes ZL3TE gave an illustrated description of the workings of the Antenna 2 x 8 switching system Based on the Network Protocol *"ShackLan"*. Band data is picked up from both the ICOM 7610 transceiver at HF1 and the ICOM 7300 used as the remote station, to select the appropriate antenna. At present, three antennas are available. It is programmed to show flashing red LEDs to warn that the antenna is already in use. Another advantage is to avoid Members having to connect and disconnect SO239 coax fittings (not practical when using the remote station). Users of the radio at HF1 should remember to reset it to *"Auto"* before leaving. The Remote station is not available for use when the Clubroom is active on Saturdays.

The switching system donated by Dr Peter Driessen ZL1XA and Wes ZL3TE to encourage more participation by Members.

Wes ZL3TE was thanked by acclamation. The meeting closed at 1445 hours
