At 5:00 am, Tropical Depression Felicia was located at 155 miles east of Kahului with maximum sustained winds of 35 mph with higher gusts.

Felicia is anticipated to make landfall in Maui County on Tuesday mid/late morning.

Amateur radio operators are encouraged to continue preparations, review action and response plans with their family, and stay tuned to the media, National Weather Service NOAA radio and informational sources.
