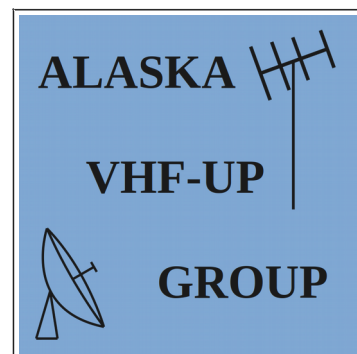

New Call

The Alaska VHF-up Group has been issued KL7VHF as a club call. To log a contact with the new call you have to catch the rover!

The Rover

The club will have a rover station visiting four different grids on the 18th. Remember, rovers can be contacted for points AGAIN at each new grid.

Grid Squares

| Grid | Location | Arrival | Departure |
|------|-----------------------------|---------|-----------|
| BP51 | Meadow Road (near Flattop) | 1000 | 1200 |
| BP41 | Point Woronzof | 1230 | 1400 |
| BP50 | Seward Highway: Rainbow Tr. | 1445 | 1600 |
| BP40 | Sterling Hwy: near mile 64 | 1900 | 2000 |

All times are LOCAL.

Rover Frequencies

| Band | SSB Frequency | FM Frequency |
|-------|---------------|----------------|
| 6 M | 50.125 | 52.525 |
| 2 M | 144.200 | 146.520 |
| 70 cm | 432.200 | 446.000 |

Tip: Start listening on 146.52-FM at the arrival times.
