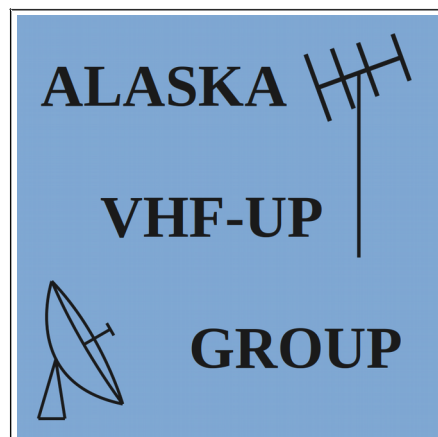


# KL7VHF Rover Run
