
"Unreached" people groups do not have easy access to Christian resources and taking the Gospel to these areas can be dangerous and difficult.

<u>Turkey</u>

Turkey is frequently ranked among the top ten holiday destinations in the world. Istanbul, its cultural capital, was, under its former name Constantinople, the center of Eastern Christianity for more than 1,000 years. It was at Antioch (now Antakya) that the word "Christian" was first coined (Acts 11:26). Paul invested much of his ministry in Ephesus, and his letters to the early churches in Galatia and Colossae - all in modern Turkey - as were the seven churches in Revelation chapters 2 and 3.

Today, Turkey's 81 million population is 99% Muslim, predominantly Sunni but with a large minority of Alevi Shias and Bektashi Sufis. Christians are around 0.2% mainly from historic non-Turkish ethnic groups.

While the constitution is silent on Christianity and other religions, neither prohibiting nor permitting them, there is increasing hostility towards anything that is not Muslim. The Hagia Sofia, a large church built in 537 AD and used as a museum was recently made an active mosque.. The seizure of church properties by the state has been a recurring form of persecution. But in 2011 the government licensed a building in Van province used as house church by Protestant Christians.

The press is often hostile to Christians, and in 2009 the Ministry of Education introduced a new school textbook aimed at 13-year-olds, which encouraged discrimination against Christians.

<u>Uzbekistan</u>

The construction of a new registered church in Uzbekistan, in partnership with Barnabas, allows hundreds more Christians to meet for worship without breaking the law. Many small congregations have to meet in private homes, making them vulnerable to police raids and heavy fines.

It was the first time that permission had been granted to construct an officially registered church building in Uzbekistan in the last 20 years. The new building seats 400 people, allowing a further six congregations to meet there for worship. Barnabas' church partner said, "Hundreds of Christians who feared to meet at home can now gather in an official church building."

Kyrgyzstan

FEBC has received a long-awaited license to open a radio station in Kyrgyzstan's southern capital city of Osh. This station will deliver the Gospel to people who were born into Islam. They live without hope for this life or eternity and have not experienced the comfort of God's promises. They regularly suffer from domestic violence, the evils of rampant drug trafficking, and recently, the COVID-19 outbreak without an adequate healthcare system.

When listeners tune in and hear the Gospel, they will hear things they have never heard before, about life, love, forgiveness, hope and salvation in Jesus Christ.


INDIA

Reach Beyond Australia recently launched an new project using WhatsApp, in partnership with *Christianityworks*. WhatsApp is a free mobile app used to send text and voice messages. It is hugely popular in India. It can reach thousands of people in an instant.

The pilot was launched in five languages: English, Tamil, Kannada, Marathi and Hindi. Already these messages of hope are being listened to by thousands of people, far exceeding the earlier estimates.

WhatsApp provides indicators when the message was sent, received, and that it was listened to. With vast numbers of people in lockdown, people have stayed online like never before, presenting a wonderful opportunity to share messages of hope during times of great uncertainty.

Tanzania

Radio Uhai FM broadcasts from Tabora in western Tanzania, famous for the honey it produces. Programming features Gospel music and teaching from the Word of God in the Swahili language.

Khadija, who was spiritually lost, was sick in bed. He listened to the radio to fill the quiet hours. Hearing a pastor on Radio Uhai, he picked up his telephone to call them to ask for prayer and healing. The pastor prayed for Khadija live on the air. The next day he felt much better! Amazed at what he had heard and seen, he immediately went to the pastor's church and gave his life to Christ.

Magreth, a Christ follower, was concerned about her unbelieving children. A pastor on Radio Uhai encouraged her to begin fervently praying for them. A month later, the children began listening to the radio with her and asked to go with her to church, where they accepted Christ and were baptized.

People are coming to Christ, saying they heard the Gospel on the radio and are joining churches. Radio Uhai receives over 300 cell phone calls and texts every day.

The station went on the air in April of 2017 with the goal of "Reaching Tanzania with the Word of God." It has been faithfully sharing this message, sweeter than honey. The equipment was provided by SonSet Solutions located in Elkhart, IN.

Nigeria

TWR's newly installed 200 kW Oasis transmitter in Nigeria began broadcasting this year. Station Director Garth Kennedy has led the 17-month, \$1.4 million project to expand the capacity of their West African Transmitting Station, known as WATS.

With the largest economy and population on the African continent, Nigeria is splintered between the mostly Muslim north and the Christian south. Abductions and attacks by northern groups such as Boko Haram and Fulani herdsmen are frequently in the international news.

Abdoulaye Sangho, TWR's director for the region, says, "Through its transmission of the Word of God, millions have the opportunity to hear God speak in their own heart languages."

India (In the Tamil Language)

"I am from a Hindu family. I earn my living through driving auto rickshaw (tuk-tuk). During this Covid-19 time, I am not allowed to go on the road and I am unable to earn my living.

"I was distressed, was not able to sleep and suffered in my body as well. When financially I was not able to cope, I thought that I wouldn't get anything back.

That evening, I planned to walk out of my house and end my life. I couldn't walk for long and I sat with pain in my body. A gentleman came and asked if I needed anything and I told him my story.

"He said 'There is only one hope for you. I can't talk too much now as there are many police going around (People are not allowed to be outside during the lock-down.) but I will give you this book. Take it with you.... your life will change forever.'

"I took the book and read a few lines, it said 'Christ died for you...' I cried out loud and walked back. I immediately called the phone number given in that book. A man of God prayed for me. Today I have the heart to live. I have received hope through Christ Jesus! I have accepted Him as my personal Savior."

Yemen

Recent stories told by Yemeni believers give testimony to the power of radio. Shortwave programs are powerfully impacting people's lives with their message of the light and hope that only Jesus Christ can bring.

A rural listener, Ahmed, responded by sending a text message to the producer. He included a bible verse in the text. The producer asked how he could best support him. To his surprise, Ahmed asked for a Bible. The producer said that it seemed that Ahmed already had access to a Bible since he had quoted scripture in his text, to which Ahmed replied, "When I listen to the program, I use a cassette recorder and record it so I can play it back and write down the words from the Holy book. I must have most of it written down by now!"

Many are risking their lives to be baptized. Reliable sources inside the country estimate that more than 60 people took this step last year. Hundreds more professed faith. We are using media creatively to disciple these believers, build them up and encourage them to reach out to others.
