RADIOTELETYPE: A TOOL FOR GOD'S WORK

TO HAVE AN UNATTENDED RADIO STATION TYPE OUT INCOMING MISSIONARY TRAFFIC AT 60 W.P.M. FOR THE OPERATOR TO FORWARD OR FILE WHEN HE RETURNS: -- THIS IS NOW BEING DONE AT RADIO VILLAGE (EL2N), AT TRANSWORLD RADIO (W2CCE), AT S.I.M. NEW YORK HEADQUARTERS VIA JACK BUCK (K2AXO) SEVERAL TIMES A WEEK.

RADIO TELETYPE (RTTY) HAS BECOME AN IMPORTANT AND GROWING MODE OF A.R.M.S. COMMUNICATION DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS; AND IT CAN BECOME MUCH MORE USEFUL IF MORE A.R.M.S. MEMBERS WILL FURTHER THE DEVELOPMENT OF RTTY TRANSCONTINENTAL AND OVERSEAS CIRCUITS.

RTTY IS NOT A REPLACEMENT FOR SSB. AS A MEANS OF FELLOWSHIP AND FOR CHRISTIAN CONFERENCE PHONE REMAINS SUPERIOR TO TELETYPE. FOR THE EFFICIENT AND RAPID EXCHANGE OF CHRISTIAN BUSINESS WITH INHERENT LEGIBILITY AND WRITTEN RECORD AND MINIMUM CONSUMPTION OF TIME RTTY IS HARD TO BEAT. HOW OFTEN WE FIND WE CANNOT WRITE FAST ENOUGH TO COPY A MESSAGE ACCURATELY WITHOUT REPEATS! HOW MUCH TIME IT TAKES TO HANDLE MESSAGE TRAFFIC AT NET TIME! HOW EASILY WE FORGET THOSE ITEMS WE DID NOT WRITE DOWN OR WHICH WE JOTTED DOWN IN WRITING WE COULD NOT DECIPHER LATER! TELETYPE ELIMINATES THESE TROUBLES BY TYPING A PERMANENT RECORD OF INCOMING AND OUTGOING TRANSMISSIONS, BY SENDING AND RECEIVING AT SIXTY WORDS A MINUTE IF A SIMPLE TAPE DEVICE IS USED AS AUXILIARY EQUIPMENT.

TODAY YOU CAN CALL K2AXO, W2CCE AND EL2N (RTTY CALL FOR EL2F) ON 21.1 MHZ., SEND YOUR MESSAGE AND FROM YOUR OWN STATION TURN OFF THEIR EQUIPMENT. YOU CAN EVEN PUNCH TAPE AT W2CCE BY SENDING THE APPROPRIATE CHARACTER SEQUENCE SO THAT YOUR OWN MESSAGE IS ON TAPE AND ALL READY TO BE RELAYED BY BOB DICKINSON AT 60 W.P.M. WHEN HE GETS BACK FROM WORK. FURTHERMORE, BOB LEAVES HIS STATION ON 21.1 MHZ. STAND-BY ALL DAY AND, 3.635 KHZ., ALL NIGHT.

THIS SOUNDS COMPLICATED, ELABORATE, AND EXPENSIVE. IT REALLY ISN'T. YOU CAN PROBABLY USE YOUR PRESENT RECEIVER AND TRANSMITTER WITHOUT DISABLING THEM FOR OTHER USE. ONLY THE TRANSMITTER NEEDS SIMPLE MODIFICATION; AND YOU CAN BUY OR BUILD A RECEIVING TERMINAL UNIT TO DEMODULATE AUDIO SIGNALS INTO SQUARE WAVE D.C. PULSES THAT ACTIVATE THE PRINTER.

TELETYPE PRINTER-KEYBOARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT COSTS RANGING FROM "FREE F.O.B." TO THE PRICE OF AN OLD RECEIVER. THERE ARE A.R.M.S. MEMBERS WHO HAVE THE "KNOW-HOW," WHO WILL LEND YOU LITERATURE AND SCHEMATICS, AND WHO WILL PILOT YOU THROUGH A RTTY BEGINNERS TROUBLE AND UNCERTAINTY. WE HOPE TO HAVE A TELETYPE FAMILIARIZATION SESSION AT THE ANNUAL MEETING THIS SUMMER IN COLORADO. COME - SEE - HEAR!

P.S. - I HAVE FOR YEARS BEEN AGAINST MISSIONARY TELETYPE AS BEING TOO COMPLICATED, EXPENSIVE, AND UNRELIABLE. IN DECEMBER THE SPIRIT MOVED ME TO TRY IT OUT. BY FEBRUARY FIRST I WAS "ON THE AIR," THANKS TO EL2N, W2CCE AND K2AXO, MY ADVISORS. THIS ARTICLE SHOWS YOU HOW RADIO TELETYPE LOOKS TO ME TODAY!
