Mart Brett KT4K get in with us when he can and adds a lot to our net keeping us updated on what is going on in Israel.




#### 2012 ARMS Conference Update:

our Thursday Northwest ARMS 75 phone Net we heard a very apparent buzzing QRM on the Net frequency of 3.965. Wayne, VA7GF. looked up the World Wide Directory of



stations and found one operating at that frequency in South Korea. What we were hearing was a jamming signal that most likely originated in North Korea. We were still able to operate our Net, but were made to realize afresh there is that kind of a battle going on in the world.

In the 1960s I was with Missionary Tapes in Pasadena and we were producing Gospel broadcasts in a number of languages and dialects. One Chinese broadcast from the FEBC station in Manila was being regularly jammed from a station in Mainland China with anti-Christian comments. The Manila station's response was to broadcast on station breaks the first part of Psalm 14:1, without comment: "The fool has said in his heart there is no God..." Within a week the jamming had stopped.



As time continues to fly by and we move closer and closer to our return to the United States, we increasingly realize how vitally important it is for us to be able to communicate clearly the process we're going through and how the Lord is directing us to serve Him in this next chapter of our lives. Because many churches and individuals have invested sacrificially to enable us to serve the Lord as missionaries in this part of the world, we want make sure that everyone understands the details.

Again, we want to express our appreciation to you, as a faithful partner with us in ministry for many years. Your prayers and sacrificial giving has enabled the Lord's work here in the Philippines to move forward and we rejoice in seeing many lives touched with the transforming power of the Gospel. The Lord is good!



We realize that in any of life's major transitions that the details are not all revealed at once. We have been in regular communications with Dr. Marty Shaw, our Asian Director, Dave Childers, WorldVenture's North Central Region Team Leader, and WorldVenture leadership in Littleton. WorldVenture has asked both of us to continue in ministry on a part-time basis after our retirement from full-time missionary service on *March 1, 2013*. We've attached a *Special Update Newsletter* with more information concerning our transition and prayer needs. The ministry we will be stepping into has the potential of greatly expanding the Lord's work around the world as a new generation of missionaries are passed the baton. We are seeing the Lord raise up young people who are deeply committed to God's Word and the expansion of His kingdom in a very fragmented, unstable and hopeless world, and we're thankful that WorldVenture has asked us to be part the process of preparing these young Christians to impact the world with *the only hope, the transforming power of Jesus Christ*. We are excited about our future assignment in the U.S. because this will enable us to use our many past experiences as missionaries in coaching potential missionary candidates, help mission appointees prepare for living overseas, and work with local churches through mission training.
