

#### WEBMASTER ARMS SECTION REPORT: By Lou Orcutt

Greetings and Blessings from the Voice of the heartland. Band conditions here have not been the best for some time now so hope the pendulum starts swinging back to good conditions soon. It has been a challenge to keep our net control stations listed currently on our web site and still not sure I have them correct but it is a privilege and an honor to be your webmaster. The chat room is back up and running on our web page and it has been useful somewhat in these times of poor band conditions but is not used that much. I am usually there when I check in to see who else might be there also. I am old fashioned and slow so please inform me of things that need changing or I have missed. I have been trying very hard to do some evangelism mission projects right here at home but it is hard with the worldview the way we have made it today. A big mission this year for me is I will be going on a mission trip through "Alaska Mission for Christ" to Akiak Alaska, June 22 through 3 July, so please keep me and our group in your prayers for support. We will be doing some sport camp, VBS, family retreats, and repairs as needed. Akiak is about an hour East of Bethel and is very isolated. For many Alaskans there is no chance to attend a church service weekly or even once a year. Our VBS trip will provide opportunities to share the Gospel. Life in Akiak is pretty bleak. Akiak's population is about 500 with roughly 70 children. Some challenges families face are drug addition, unemployment, high cost of living, alcoholism, divorce and broken relationships. There appears to be no churches in the area. We will be meeting in the school and living in the gym while there. It is in a flood plain 13 ft. above sea level, sewer lines above ground, houses built on stilts, and many living in poverty. This is a different world than we are used to with many tribal differences so we need to be non-involved in tribal problems to some extent. Christian radio station VFCM is in Bethel and our

ARMS Christian fellowship group has done some work there by James Fisher NQ7L. Akiak, ACK-ee-ack, is the Eskimo term for crossing over or the other side and is in Bethel census area. Almost 1/3 living in poverty and there will be only a few hours of darkness when we are there. Alaska is like a Welfare state, fishing industry is big but very uneven causing tribal anguish. Bethel would be the closest village with travel by plane or boat between them and there are no restaurants and only a small store with a loaf of bread costing \$7.00. Driving from Bethel to Akiak, is on the Kuskokwim River, also known as the "Ice Road". Because there are no roads connecting any of the villages of western Alaska, all travel is done either by small airplane or on the river. In the summer, primary travel is by boat, but in the winter...you wait for the river to freeze up. Akiak school is Home of the Thunderbolts. Please pray for our trip.

The Eastern Section of the ARMS Net continues to be very active. We meet Mondays and Thursdays at 7:15 AM Eastern Time and Saturdays at 9:00 AM Eastern time at 3907 kHz. We average 10 checkins on Mondays, 8 on Thursdays and from 4 to 8 on Saturdays. We maintain a prayer list which is updated each net. The list consists of both missionary and local requests. Anyone from any section is welcome to have a request put on the list or to receive the list. Please let me know. In either case my e-mail address is Ihodge50@aol.com. Net control duties are shared by net members who have been very faithful in seeing all nets are covered. Net controllers include Wil, WA3OJN, Duane, AA2I, Don,K3RYV, Bill, WB1DQT, John, WB2SQX, Tom,N7GBH, Don, WA3CMT, Paul,K2QCG and Larry, W2PT. In addition, the first Monday of each month is "Missionary Monday." On that day net members are encouraged to bring before the group a specific missionary they pray for and support. Tom (N7GBH) has done a great job on making arrangements and planning the agenda.We continue to praise the Lord for his goodness and trust God's blessings will rest on each of you in the coming days.
