WHAT IS ARMS?

The Amateur Radio Missionary Service is a fellowship of committed Christian radio amateurs and associates who are dedicated to serving missionaries, their families, friends and ministries.

ARMS is a non-denominational nonprofit organization from all walks of life throughout the world.

It was founded March 2, 1957 at the Philadelphia School of the Bible, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. One of the early functions of ARMS was to provide phone patch communication between missionaries and their families and friends. With the advent of the Internet and mobile phones, that function has largely disappeared.

We still meet on the air for fellowship, to share Scripture and prayer concerns, to assist missionaries, and to present a positive witness for Christ on the amateur bands.

The ARMS motto is taken from the Bible in Galatians 6:10 "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers."

Also, we see in 1 Cor 1:9: "God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord."
