
Upcoming Meeting

The meeting program will be suspended for this meeting.


Weekly Club Net

- If you are outside the repeater coverage area and do not have wires-x you can participate via YouTube chat or Net logger AIM.
- The Bristol-ARC wires-x room will be switched to analog for the meeting.
- After the list is made regular meeting procedure will be followed. (Call to order, prayer, pledge etc.
- Any votes that need to be taken will be done in a roll call fashion. The current roster will be available to verify membership.
- Opportunities to check in late will be given before any votes are taken or the meeting concludes.

If the virus issues continue past April, we may follow this plan for those months as well.
